

GSR.....- In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Upper Yamuna River Board (Water Resources Engineering) Recruitment Rules, 2000 and the Upper Yamuna River Board (Water Resources Engineering) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules 2002, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Member Secretary, Superintending Engineer, Executive Engineer, Assistant Engineer and Design Assistant in the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Upper Yamuna River Board namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**– (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Upper Yamuna River Board (Water Resources Engineering) Post Recruitment Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

6. **Saving.**– Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedules Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
